

Solidarity call

However, this requires network information in the form of intuition, sensitivity and, of course, messages about who urgently needs help.

Our fiat money system was about to collapse more than once, and central banks have successfully prevented this by repeatedly ventilating the patient. Appropriate comparison with the Corona Virus, which can also greatly hinder the breathing of the patient.

Now this time too. The American FED central bank has set off the next bazooka in the last few days, of course with an uncertain outcome. That could mean sooner or later that our avoidable collateral on the bank or under the pillow or anywhere else in the form of paper money could turn out to be an illusion.

We are not that far at the moment. But it is becoming increasingly apparent that this bazooka system divides mankind between the impoverished, the privileged and the ultra-rich. That is why this call to the privileged; Live solidarity before it's too late!

Let us not close our ears, mouth and heart exactly where we stand in life, because helping is a privilege.
